Optional Visits to Canterbury Cathedral and the Cathedral Archives
Friday 14 July 2017

A visit has been arranged to Canterbury Cathedral Archives on the Friday afternoon at 15:30 for which there is a charge of £11.00 per person. A tour of the cathedral has been arranged at an extra cost of £5.00 in addition to the entry fee to the Cathedral (£12.00 Full Adult) to take place at 14:00, before the tour of the Archives. The entry fee is not payable if only attending the tour of the Archives. Your leader is David Burgess.

Cathedral Tour

This will be a guided tour. We will meet by the Welcome Centre which is within the Cathedral precincts, through the Christ Church Gate and it is on your right. Christ Church Gate is at the junction of Mercery Lane and Burgate.

As there will be a Degree Congregation taking place on the day we will not have access to the Nave, Martyrdom or Chapter House. There will still be plenty to see. After the Degree Congregation has finished it may be possible to visit those places separately at the end of the afternoon.

In order to access the precincts and the Cathedral an entrance fee is payable at Christ Church Gate Entrance (£12.00 Full Adult). The extra cost of the Tour of the Cathedral is £5.00, payable in advance.

The tour commences at 14:00 from the Welcome Centre and to avoid delays please arrive ten minutes beforehand.

Cathedral Archives Tour

This will be a guided tour. We will meet by the Welcome Centre which is within the Cathedral precincts, through the Christ Church Gate and it is on your right. Christ Church Gate is at the junction of Mercery Lane and Burgate.

There is normally a fee to access the precincts payable at Christ Church Gate (£12.00 Full Adult). This entry fee is not payable if only attending the tour of the Archives. At the entrance at Christ Church Gate take the left hand passage and say you are visiting the Archives. (Showing a CARN Ticket is effective.)

The cost of the Tour of the Archives is £11.00, payable in advance.

The tour commences at 15:30 from the Welcome Centre and to avoid delays please arrive ten minutes beforehand.
