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1. APRIL 2024

The JAUNDRELL family has had a strong presence in Lancashire. The GRO Births Marriages and Deaths Index holds (at least) 669 entries; Prescott and Warrington being the most popular.

FOUNDING FAMILIES

One of the founding families in Lancashire is that of John JANDRELL and Sarah NIXON.

John and Sarah married on November 2, 1834 at St Wilfrid's chapel (rededicated as St Luke's in 1859) at Farnworth (near Prescott). The parish entry records John as an 'Overlooker of Cotton Manufactory'. The 1841 census records him as a Cotton Weaver and the 1851 as a Power Loom Weaver. After this time John moves from cotton to coal and is recorded as a Coal Miner. John was born about 1813 at Dorrington in the parish of Condover Shropshire and was baptised in the parish on October 3, 1813, the third son of Thomas (occupation labourer) and Mary JANDRELL. On census records John is variously recorded as being born in Shrewsbury Shropshire (1851), Shropshire Wales (1861), Shrewsbury Wales (1871), Prescott Lancashire (1881) and Condover Wales (1891). The year of birth is equally diverse falling between 1804-1814; in general it stays within the 1811-1814 range; however, the death GRO and burial record suggest he died aged 74 in July 1894 and therefore a birth year of 1820! They have at least six children; 5 boys and 1 girl; Benjamin (1835-1909), John (1838-1926), George (1844-1868, Isaac (1847-1924) and Martha (1850-1905). Sarah NIXON dies aged 44 years in Jun 1860 in Prescott Lancashire. There appears to be no further children between 1850-1860.

Oldham entries are limited to the family of Edward JANDRELL (1855-1919) and Eliza EDWARDS (1857-1928) and provide a previously unexplored Canadian emigration.

Edward was born at Dolfor Montgomeryshire (RD: Newtown) the middle son of John JANDRELL (1817-1893) and Susannah JONES (1825-1876). Edward is a Blacksmith/Farrier. He marries Eliza July-September 1886 in the Atcham area of Shropshire. Between 1886 and 1888 the couple relocate from Shropshire/Montgomeryshire to Oldham. Here they have 3 children Ethel born October 15, 1888, Gladys born January-February 1892 and Edward born December 14, 1900. Ethel marries Sydney NEILD June 19, 1912 and Gladys marries William MOSS (Occupation: Hat Manufacturer) December 10, 1913. Eliza travels with son Edward to Vancouver British Columbia April 1921 and she returns alone June 1924. Edward remains in Canada and dies there in 1961. Ethel also travels to Canada in 1920 to visit her cousin John CHESTER (1878-1948) the son of John CHESTER and Susannah JANDRELL of Clunn, Shropshire. Ethel and John are 'living together' at the 1931 census point in British Columbia and finally marry

September 17, 1934 in Portland Oregon. She marries in her maiden name and declares it to be her first marriage! It is unknown why they get married so late. Ethel dies of Cancer December 29, 1975 in Coquitlam, British Columbia. Gladys is the only one to have children, however, her two sons die in infancy.

2. MARCH 2024

TASK #1

A schedule for March will include the beginning of a data cleanse of JAUNDRELL in the Madeley, Shifnal and Wellington Registration Districts of Shropshire. This 3 RDs cover the South Shropshire coalfield. Miners and their families moved frequently between all three RDs which abutted one another. It makes little sense to examine them separately.

4. JANUARY 2024

New Year. New Plan! Well a revision of an old plan really.

My ONS is focused of the JAUNDRELL family name. Which is the name I hold. However I know that in truth it is not my family name. My grandfather was illegitimate and it is believed that his rightful family name would have been WILLIAMS. His mother was Jane Ellen JAUNDRELL whom I knew and lived with briefly. Unfortunately I was young and had been instructed to be uninterested in my family heritage: told that I shouldn't dig in the past because I didn't know what I might find and it would likely not be to my advantage. Oh the inherited shame of illegitimacy! Going further back in Jane Ellen's family tree I reach Joseph JAUNDRELL her double great grandfather who himself was declared a bastard by his cuckolded 'father' Abraham. Joseph was declared to be son of Joseph HAMPTON. My JAUNDRELL inheritance is therefore via my great grandmother. It is very also very firmly based in the south Shropshire coalfield. They have been coal and iron stone miners in this area since the late 1700s. My individual line has lived within a 3 mile radius of Old Park Dawley: an area that now buried deep under the foundations of Telford. Other members of Joseph's family line did however spread out within England to other coalfield areas such as Staffordshire, Lancashire, Nottinghamshire and Yorkshire. Some ventured further afield USA, Australia and New Zealand.

I am currently continuing to data cleanse my JAUNDRELL study, and as I do so, I am also exploring a few names of interest on the way that I shall refer to as 'sidetrack' events.
