

## Optional Visit to Richard III Visitor Centre and tour of Leicester Cathedral Friday 29th March 2019

We have booked 35 40 places for an optional visit to the King Richard III Visitor Centre on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> March 2019, followed by a guided tour of Leicester Cathedral. The Visitor Centre is fascinating to visit, presenting the story of King Richard III, his rise to power and death at the Battle of Bosworth Field, together with the incredible story of the 'detectives' behind the research, archaeological dig and scientific analysis carried out to confirm the remains as those of the King. The grave site where he lay undisturbed for over 500 years is a fitting end to your visit to the Centre, while during the tour of the Cathedral, you will be able to see his final resting place.



The timetable for the visit is as follows:

- 13.45 Meet at King Richard III Visitor Centre for introductory talk  
You will then have until 15.40 to visit the Centre (which also has a café)
- 15.45 Meet your tour guide at the Cathedral for a visit lasting approximately 1 hour
