to be held at The Community House, Portholme Road, Selby, North Yorkshire YO8 4QQ
on Saturday 3rd August 2019 at 9.30am for 10.00am.

Below are some additional details in advance of the seminar at which we are
expecting some 50 attendees.

A. SELBY

The Community House is a Social Enterprise owned and operated by Selby District Association of Voluntary Service and is located in a central location at the junction of Portholme Crescent and Portholme Road < <https://tinyurl.com/y3sthaek> > and within close proximity to the railway and bus stations.

B. TRAVEL TO SELBY

The postcode for your satnav is YO8 4QQ. Listed below are driving instructions from the M62 and the A1(M):

From the M62

Leave at junction 34 and take the A19 north towards Selby and York. After about 4 miles, at the 2nd roundabout, turn right onto the A63 (signed Hull A63 and York A19) then at the next roundabout turn left onto the A1041 Bawtry Road towards Selby Town Centre. After passing the left hand turn to Propsect Industrial Estate enter the 30mph speed limit and after crossing the railway line turn left onto Portholme Road (signed Superstores and P).



With the police station on your left turn right onto Portholme Crescent; The Community House is on your right, with the car park on the right just past it.

From the A1(M)

Leave at junction 42 and take the A63 towards Selby. At the 2nd roundabout, after about 8 miles, stay on the A63 towards Hull. At the third roundabout, where the A19 joins from the M62 junction 34 (see above) stay on the A63 to the 4th roundabout then turn left onto the A1041 Bawtry Road towards Selby Town Centre and follow the instructions above.

C. PARKING

There is a Pay and Display car park on Portholme Crescent adjacent to the venue (all day parking £5.40), and restriction free on street parking within a short distance. Please note that the long stay parking at the council offices on Portholme Road has closed and parking at the nearby Morrison's supermarket is time limited and strictly controlled by ANPR cameras.
