ORA is an automated assistant for online repositories including Ancestry, FamilySearch, FindMyPast, and also works with hundreds of other sites.

ORA is designed to reduce the time you spend extracting information so you can focus on the fun part: the research!

ORA saves you time.

- ORA adds a **control panel** in your browser window when you are visiting online repositories.
- ORA helps you **track your usage** of records in the collections of the repository.
- ORA helps you **extract data** from the records you find and supports **templates** to customize data entry for both data records and citations.

ORA combines a **Windows** program with a web browser extension. The browser extension is available for **Chrome, Edge, Firefox, and Opera**.
