Tips and Wrinkles Seminar

to be held on Saturday July 13th 2024 at Littleton Millennium Memorial Hall, The Hall Way, Littleton, Winchester, SO22 6QL at 9.30am for 10.00am.

Below are some additional details in advance of the seminar.

A. VENUE - Littleton Millennium Memorial Hall

The Hall < <http://littletonvillagehall.co.uk/> > is situated in Littleton, about 2.5 miles north of Winchester. There are 4 disabled parking spaces reserved by the entrance to the hall and easy wheelchair access to the whole building; there is a disabled access toilet.

B. HOW TO GET THERE

For those not using a SatNav then the best access point is off the A34 **but be careful as the signs can be tricky to follow.**

a. From the M3

Exit at Junction 9 and take the A34 heading north and follow the directions in section b:

b. on the A34 heading north

From the south, take the Salisbury (A30) exit; the local (white) sign shows “Worthy Down, South Wonston, Sutton Scotney, Wherwell and Stockbridge”. Go to the top of the slip road and turn left onto the “Three Maids Hill” roundabout [then follow the directions in section d]



c. on the A34 heading south

After Sutton Scotney Services just south of the A303, continue for 1.5 miles filter left towards Winchester on the B3420; the local (white) sign shows Littleton.



At the first roundabout take the second exit marked “Winchester, Salisbury, Stockbridge.”

After crossing the bridge over the A34 you will reach the “Three Maids Hill” roundabout [then follow the directions in section d]



d. from “Three Maids Hill” roundabout
Proceed across/round the “Three Maids Hill” roundabout to the third exit marked for Littleton.



Continue down Stud Lane for one mile to the T-junction and turn left towards Littleton as shown on the old style signpost.



Continue south towards Littleton on 'Main Road' for three quarters ($\frac{3}{4}$) of a mile going past the church and the Running Horse pub until you reach 'The Hall Way' on your left.



Turn left into 'The Hall Way' and after 300 feet turn left into the Millennium Hall car park.

e. returning to the A34

When leaving Littleton Millennium Hall return in the same direction, turning right onto 'Main Road' and continuing for three quarters ($\frac{3}{4}$) of a mile.

Do not miss the right hand turn towards the A34 which is signposted Kingsworthy not the A34



f. Bus

Stagecoach bus number 13 leaves Winchester bus station at 08.45 and arrives at "Littleton Church Lane" at 08.58. The nearest bus stop is at the junction of Main Road and The Hall Way. The return bus is 16.45 (17.00) but hopefully another kind delegate might be able to offer a lift back into (or even from) Winchester?

g. Train

Winchester is on the South Western main line from London Waterloo to Southampton Central, Bournemouth and Weymouth or to Portsmouth Harbour.

h. Taxi

From Winchester railway station will cost around £10 each way.

C. PARKING

The very large Recreation Ground Car Park adjoins the Hall, with space for 50 cars. If necessary, in the event that there is also a function on the recreation ground further parking will be available in the adjoining field.

Access to the Hall and the car park is restricted by a barrier to vehicles exceeding 2.2m (7ft 2ins) in height.
